

Torridon Sea Tours

Check timetable, need to book

A local family has set up Torridon Sea Tours from Shieldaig village. A comfortable, stable catamaran has been kitted out to a high standard. Warm rugs, indoor and outdoor seating, great little loo, binoculars and a small galley provide many creature comforts. We have been out with them on a number of occasions and never felt sea-sick. Safety is paramount for the Livingstone family, along with providing a great experience.

We would highly recommend the all-day sea tours, as you get further out into the Inner Sound and have greater chances of seeing Whales, Basking Sharks, Dolphins, Puffins and Gannets to name a few. The first class experience is reflected in the price but is well worth it – for me the Rona and Shiant day trips have been ‘once in a lifetime’ type experiences.



April – October and weather dependent. They create the timetable for the week ahead, usually Sunday / Monday and circulate a weekly timetable to us. No wildlife is guaranteed as it is wild and has no timetable; however, certain creatures are more likely to be around at certain times of year. E.g. Spring for the Puffins, late summer for Whales and Basking Sharks.
